

Equality Impact Assessment of the review of H&S Policy on Use of X

This includes x-raying of new and expectant mothers and young persons to safeguard their health, safety and well-being.

In addition, persons who could exceed stipulated dose constraints if x-rayed as part of a University related x-ray activity could be excluded from an activity.

Consideration must also be given to those who could be impacted upon if in the vicinity of an x-ray set whilst in operation.

Associated X-ray activity documents and the x-ray set operator should ensure the health, safety and well-being of all persons who could be affected.
